Dear City Council and Parks and Recreation Department,

I am writing on behalf of the Yeti Rugby Football Club to advocate for the pressing need for dedicated artificial turf fields within our city. As one of the leading rugby clubs in the region, our commitment goes beyond just the game. We are devoted to fostering an environment where people from various age groups can come together, learn, and compete. Our members range in age from a budding 6-year-old enthusiast to our experienced 65-year-old veterans.

Currently, our club boasts over 115 dedicated members and mini rugby squad of 30+. However, as the sport gains traction and as our community involvement continues to grow, we project a significant increase in field time requirements, both during our main men's league season from May to July, and notably during the shoulder seasons.

The presence of artificial turf fields would greatly benefit our club and other sports clubs in the area for various reasons. Natural grass fields, especially during the shoulder seasons, are prone to wear and tear, making them unsuitable for rigorous sports activities. Artificial turfs, on the other hand, can withstand more frequent usage without significant degradation. Moreover, our club is keen on organizing a shoulder season tournament or event between February-June and September-December. Having access to artificial turf fields would make this ambition feasible.

Additionally, having lighting facilities would be a game-changer. As our city's days become shorter during the fall and winter months, it becomes increasingly challenging to find suitable times for practice and matches. Proper lighting extends the usability of these fields into the evenings.

By providing dedicated artificial turf fields with lighting, the City of Salmon Arm would be making a significant contribution towards fostering local sports, boosting community spirit, and ensuring safer and more reliable playing conditions for its residents.
