

**WHEREAS** both Council and the Active Transportation Advisory Committee (ATAC) have received feedback regarding multi-user etiquette and safety concerns, particularly along the Foreshore Trail, including calls for increased signage in key locations and an ongoing need for clear information about the rules and safety criteria associated with joining the provincial electric kick scooter pilot project;

**AND WHEREAS** on October 6, 2025, the ATAC recommended that Council prioritize a public education campaign regarding safety, signage, and etiquette for active transportation usage, which is directly supported by the City's Active Transportation Network Plan, which references addressing active transportation usage safety concerns in its 37 recommended actions.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that Council request staff to report back on the following at the February 9, 2026 Regular Council Meeting:

- potential communication strategies developed in collaboration with community partners to encourage safety and proper etiquette among active transportation users;
- recommendations for the installation of appropriate signage in key locations; and
- consideration of necessary budgetary support.
